

About the study programme

- The EdLearn programme aims to train experts in the areas of research on learning and sociology of education
- Throughout the studies, a strong emphasis is placed on students' research skills.
- The Master's thesis is considered an important opportunity for specialization in the programme.
- The Finnish-German Master Programme in Education is a double degree option that leads to obtaining two master's degrees (UTU and Univ. Regensburg)
- This master's degree programme does
 not provide the students with a formal
 teaching qualification.

- Altogether min. 120 ECTS credits



Master's Thesis

- You can choose your thesis topic, it is not assigned to you.
- You don't need to approach a potential supervisor beforehand. There will be a responsible supervisor from the department.
- The thesis process involves seminars where students share their ideas, interests and progress.
- Usually students work independently but it is an option to work in an existing research group.



Study time

- 2 academic years
- Academic year runs from 1 August until 31 July
- 2 semester: autumn and spring
- During summer students can take book exams, work on their thesis, do an internship, return home or stay in Turku.
 - Contact teaching ends approximately in late May.

Time to apply!

- The application is open from 8th to 22nd of January 2025 (note: Finnish time)
- Fill the electronic application at www.studyinfo.fi.
- Read the application instructions carefully before the online form opens: https://www.utu.fi/en/study-at-utu/how-when-to-apply
- Prepare for the application process in advance: language test, required documents etc.



General admission criteria

- you have a nationally recognized first cycle degree – typically a Bachelor's degree – from an accredited institution of higher education and (if applicable in the country of the degree) from a nationally accredited degree programme
- your degree corresponds to at least 180 ECTS (European credits) or to three years of full-time study
- your degree gives eligibility to master level studies in the country where it was issued
- you have excellent English language skills and a certificate that proves those skills. See instructions: https://www.utu.fi/en/study-at-utu/language-requirements-for-masters-degree-programmes



Programme specific eligibility

- Persons who have completed a Bachelor's degree in education, adult education or special education are eligible to apply to the programme.
- Also applicants who have a Bachelor's degree from other fields of study, and who have either an official teacher's qualification, or who can prove a clear affinity to educational sciences, are eligible to apply to the programme.

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Student selection

- The decision for admission will be based on the evaluation of:
 - verified proficiency in English language
 - programme specific eligibility
 - previous degree(s) and motivation letter



Tuition fees and scholarhips

- Scholarships are available for students subject to tuition fee
- UTU's scholarships are awarded based on academic merits and success in the programme specific student selection.
- Applying for a scholarship is simple: just indicate "yes" to the appropriate question on your online application form for the programme.
- Information regarding the scholarship decision is included in the admission offer for those admitted to the programme
