Complex challenges such as climate change, biodiversity crisis, social inequality, poverty, preservation of cultural heritage require expertise and know-how related to building positive futures.




Educating the next generation of sustainable managers, entrepreneurs and experts who are committed to both creating positive social and environmental impacts and economic prosperity.

### Programme study plan – what do we study here?

- The studies will involve team-work and group assignments to address practical problems from business life combined with theory
- The courses will include both oral and written presentations a necessary skill in today's working life
- The courses will include guest speakers, for example, entrepreneurs from our Entrepreneur-in-Residence program
- Many courses include experiential elements such as working with the stakeholders and providing solutions for practical problems (e.g. Entrepreneurial Action –course)
- We work closely with Boost Turku, possible to gain study credits from participating their 'Startup Journey' – a summer accelerator programme (https://www.boostturku.org/about)

- The Bachelor's degree in Sustainable and Social Entrepreneurship offers valuable skills and perspectives to individuals who want to make a positive impact on society, the environment and the economy

  - By working in the organisations at the local, national or international level for example in units targeting or advising on sustainability development goals
  - By working in the third sector for example in sustainability think tanks, research institutes and other non-governmental organizations

# How to stand out in the application process?

- Admission quota for the programme is 20
- You are eligible to apply if you have an upper secondary qualification which provides eligibility to University-level Bachelor's studies OR you have a higher University degree. Documents must be attached in the application form.
- Two different admission groups:
  - Admission group I (70%) Admission is based on SAT test
    - Required sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing & Mathematics
    - Minimum grade requirements: SAT total score 1150, Mathematics score 600
    - Score report has to be attached in the application form
  - Admission group II (30%) Admission is certificate-based
    - Only for Finnish Matriculation Examination, IB, EB, or RP/DIA qualification. Admission scores follow national scoring guidelines.
    - Minimum grade requirements: any passing grade in Mathematics (Advanced syllabus) or at least grade C in Mathematics (Basic syllabus)
    - Proof of English language proficiency: a sufficient grade in your corresponding degree or other proof of language proficiency attached in the application form
