To learn the principles and limitations of machine learning and Al approaches for biosignals and health data. To learn how to build machine learning models suitable for these data types. To learn how to derive predictions from the analysis results. To learn how to improve the analysis/prediction accuracy by fusing different data sources. To develop practical skills in biosignal analysis by doing hands-on exercises.

Feature extraction and machine learning methods are discussed in the context of health and biosignal data. Machine learning models suitable for different data types are reviewed. 

General Admission Criteria

Bachelor's Degrees

- You are an eligible applicant for Bachelor-level studies if you have an upper secondary qualification which provides eligibility to University-level Bachelor's studies in the country where it was awarded.
- Admission is based on the SAT test (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Mathematics sections).
- Please read the full programme-specific admission criteria before you apply.



General eligibility when applying to Bachelor's degree programmes

- You are an eligible applicant for Bachelor-level studies if you have one of the following qualifications:
 - the Finnish matriculation examination
 - the International Baccalaureate (IB)
 - the European Baccalaureate (EB)
 - Reifeprüfung/Die Deutsche Internationale Abiturprüfung in Finland (Deutsche Schule Helsinki)
 - other comparable upper secondary educational qualification which provides eligibility to University-level Bachelor-studies in the country in question.
 - an applicant with a higher degree than the ones mentioned will also be considered eligible.



General eligibility when applying to Bachelor's degree programmes

- If you are applying with the Finnish Matriculation Examination, IB, EB or RP/DIA qualification (Admission Group II), you do not need to sit for the SAT test.
- > All other applicants must have the SAT test completed and their score report attached on the application form. (Admission Group I)
- Required test sections (for both Bachelor's degree programmes):
 - Total score: at least 1150
 - Math: at least 600
 - Evidence-Based Reading and Writing
 - Scores lower than those mentioned above will not be considered for admission.
- SAT scores typically available within 2–4 weeks.
- Two test dates still available in 2024:
 - November 2 (register by 18 October)
 - December 7
- You must register an account on the College Board website, search for a test site close to your location, and register for the test.




General eligibility when applying to Bachelor's degree programmes: Language requirements

- If you are applying in *Admission Group I*, that is, based on the **SAT test**, you **do not** need to provide separate proof of your English language skills.
- If you are applying in Admission Group II, that is, based on your Finnish Matriculation, IB, EB, or RP/DIA qualification, you must either reach a sufficient grade in a designated English subject in your corresponding degree, or provide other proof of English language skills.
 - See our full <u>language requirements</u> for all possible methods of proving English language skills when applying to Bachelor's degree programmes.

- Bachelor's Degree or other first level University degree
 - minimum 3 years in length

 - No exceptions will be made on the language requirements!



Previous degree





Language requirements

- We accept the following international English language tests:
 - TOEFL iBT: a minimum overall score of 92 and the writing test score 22 or more
 - IELTS Academic: an overall band score of 6.5 and the writing test score 6.0. or more.
 - PTE Academic: a minimum overall score of 62 and the writing test score 42 or more
 - We also accept C2 Proficiency, C1 Advanced, and YKI (certain result requirements apply to these as well).
- Test result report form must be attached on the application form.
 - The test result must be available and attached to the application form by the end of the supplementation period (29 January 2025) for verification purposes.
 - The test result must be verifiable for at least one month after the application time has ended (22 February 2025)


