Bicycles


- Completed bicycle parking areas at Aurum and Professorinkuja (2021/2022)
- Bicycle storage with frame-lock stands equipped at Agora for staff (2022)
- Bicycle pumps available for loan at the campus information points (2022)
- Design and painting of street surface signs guiding to bicycle parking areas on Turku campus (2024)







- A map listing bicycle parking facilities on the intranet and public websites (2023)
- Addition of covered and uncovered framelock stands on the Turku and Rauma campuses (2024)













- Actions by the City of Turku: transforming nearby routes to be bicycle-friendly (Rehtorinpellonkatu bicycle street in 2023 and Inspehtorinkatu village road in 2024)

Electric scooters

Streamlining scooter parking and innovating parking solutions:

Establishing designated parking and no-parking zones in operators' apps [GPS boundaries] and installing traffic signs indicating scooter parking areas on the Turku and Rauma campuses (2022)





- University scooter no-parking and parking areas added to the City of Turku's Service Map (2022) Service Map (turku.fi)
- University's own scooter parking rack at Publicum (2022)
- Painting of scooter parking spaces on the Turku campus (2024)
- Actions by the City of Turku: collaboration with operators; installation of scooter racks and parking spaces near the campus





Cars

- Day parking as an alternative to monthly permits (2022): staff members who drive to work less frequently can purchase a daily parking permit [€2.50/day]
- Mapping of accessible parking spaces on the Turku and Rauma campuses for the Automobile and Touring Club of Finland's mobile app (2022)
- Electric vehicle charging stations available for staff use in Agora's upper garage (2022)
- Merging of staff parking zones on the Turku campus (2023): parking is now allowed across the entire campus with the same permit






Other developments

- Strengthening communication through intranet and weekly newsletters
- Additional area signage on the Turku campus (2023)
- Utilizing the Tuudo app, for example, to reach new students (2023)
- Mapping of locker rooms with showers: staff members can request access to the locker room nearest to their workstation (2024)





- Survey on commuting conditions for staff (2024)
- Updated Turku campus map for the university's public website and intranet (2024)
- Outdoor furniture, such as table sets and benches, for the Turku campus (2024)
